265 incidents received by SPPG

significantly lower than other years (686 in 2018)

24% reported anonymously

42% decrease from 2018

246 incidents reviewed and closed in year (183 known and 63 anonymous)

44 incidents graded as medium or high risk

17% caused actual harm

Key actions by SPPG

- Seven Yellow Card Reports submitted to MHRA
- New Community Pharmacy Anonymous Incidents Website launched
- 10 pieces of learning issued from SPPG
